### **Around Komaba-todaimae Station** 駒場東大前駅界隈

Many educational institutions are gathered here, including the University of Tokyo in front of the station As there is also a large park, this is an area which, while bustling, also has a relaxed atmosphere.



# Around Ikejiri-ohashi Station

Just off the large street in front of the station you will find a tranquil residential area with small stores lining the streets. Nearby there is an aerial garden and an area of the Meguro River which is lively when the cherry blossoms are in bloom.

# Around Naka-meguro Station

With highly convenient transportation, there are many eateries, general shop, and clothes store lining the area under the Tokyu Toyoko Line tracks and along the Meguro River. Local events are held throughout the year, such as when the cherry blossoms are in bloom, making this an always lively area.



### Around Meguro Station

There are many office buildings around the station, and it is a lively area with many eateries. Meguro Gajoen is around three minutes on foot descending Gyonin-zaka going west from the station, and descending from Gonnosuke-zaka, the Meguro River, with its famous lines of cherry blossom trees, is around 5 minutes on foot.



### Around Yutenji Station

There are many shopping streets and various eateries around the station It is a peaceful area and comparatively free of traffic.

### **Around Gakugei-daigaku Station** This area, including under the tracks of the Tokyu Toyoko Line, has lively shopping arcades
